CIL OF THE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

ARTICLE 1. Sewer Rates Amended

Section 3 of Chapter 10 of the Angus Code of Ordinances shall be amended as follows:

A. Sewer Service Fees Established

for sever service furnished by the Town of Angus is hereby established:

\$12.00 Residential tion per anotal. \$12.00 per connection per month

\$20.00 Small Volume Commercial \$20.00 per connection per month

Established by City Council based on water usage on case-by-case basis

Any use other than residential shall be considered commercial. More than one (1) residential under commercial unit per connection shall be classified under commercial rates. Mixed residential and commercial use shall be classified as commercial.

ARTICLE 2. Severability Clause

That should any article or section of this ordinance be decreed to be void, the invalidity of such article or section shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and that each article and section or portion thereof not decreed to be invalid shall remain valid and enforceable.

ARTICLE 3. Conflicting Ordinances Repealed

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances that are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby repealed.

ARTICLE 4. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage and publication as the law requires.
