

AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING THE 1% CITY SALES TAX ON RESIDENTIAL USE OF GAS AND ELECTRICITY AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1979

WHEREAS, by acts of the Texas Legislature heretofore passed, the 1% City Sales Tax presently levied on residential use of gas and electricity will automatically expire on October 1, 1979, unless a city, by majority vote of its governing body, adopt an ordinance continuing the imposition of the 1% City Sales Tax on residential use of gas and electricity from and after October 1, 1979; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be to the best interest of the citizens of the Town of Angus to continue said 1% City Sales Tax;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the City Commission of the Town of Angus, Texas, that the 1% City Sales Tax heretofore imposed on the residential use of gas and electricity be, and IT IS HEREBY, continued past October 1, 1979, until otherwise abolished by law.

PASSED by majority vote on first reading the 27 day of February, 1979.

PASSED by majority vote on second reading the 20 day of March, 1979.
