AN ORDINANCE CONTINUING THE 1% CITY SALES TAX ON RESIDENTIAL USE OF GAS AND ELECTRICITY AFTER OCTOBER 1, 1979

WHEREAS, by acts of the Texas Legislature heretofore passed, the 1% City Sales Tax presently levied on residential use of gas and electricity will automatically expire on October 1, 1979, unless a city, by majority vote of its governing body, adopt an ordinance continuing the imposition of the 1% City Sales Tax on residential use of gas and electricty from and after October 1, 1979; and

WHEREAS, it is deemed to be to the best interest of the citizens of the Town of Angus to continue said 1% City Sales Tax;

IT IS THEREFORE ORDAINED by the City Commission of the Town of Angus, Texas, that the 1% City Sales Tax heretofore imposed on the residential use of gas and electricty be, and IT IS HEREBY, continued past October 1, 1979, until otherwise abolished by law.
