ORDINANCE NO. 121

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 58-83 OF THE ANGUS CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO NEW SEWER RATES FOR HOMES AND BUSINESSES AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Angus, Texas hereby desires to properly ensure that all sewer rates be as follows:

1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS that "SECTION 58-83 SEWER RATE" be amended to read as follows:

The following schedule of monthly fees for sewer service furnished by the city is established:

Residential	\$16.00 per connection per month beginning July 12, 2005 and increasing to \$20.00 per connection per month on January 1, 2006.
Small volume commercial	\$ 40.00 per connection beginning July 12, 2005.
Large volume commercial and industrial	Established by city council based on water usage on case-by-case basis.

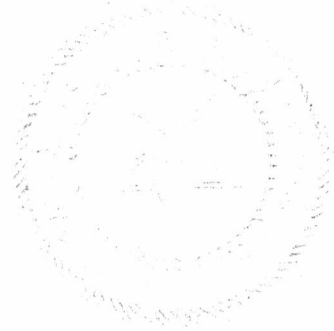
2. That should any section or provision of this ordinance be decreed to be void by a court-of-law, the invalidity of such section or provision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and that each section, provision or portion thereof not decreed to be invalid shall remain valid and enforceable.

3. This ordinance was PASSED AND APPROVED on July 12, 2005 and took effect immediately.

ORDINANCE NO. 122

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS AMENDING SECTION 58-82 OF THE ANGUS CODE OF ORDINANCES PERTAINING TO NEW SEWER CONNECTION FEES WITHIN THE CITY OF ANGUS, PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council of Angus, Texas hereby desires to properly ensure that all connections to its sewer system be done in a proper manner, now therefore


1. BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS that "SECTION 58-82. SEWER CONNECTION FEES" be amended to read as follows:

"A sanitary sewer connection fee of \$250.00 for each sewer tap shall be paid to the city for a sewer connection at the time the application is made for service. In addition to this fee, the applicant for service shall pay the actual cost for materials and labor required to make the connection."


2. That should any section or provision of this ordinance be decreed to be void by a court-of-law, the invalidity of such section or provision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance and that each section, provision or portion thereof not decreed to be invalid shall remain valid and enforceable.

3. This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its passage.
