

ORDINANCE # 166

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY OF ANGUS CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 62 - ZONING, ARTICLE V – SUPPLEMENTARY DISCTICT REGULATIONS, DIVISION 4 – OFF-STREET PARKING AND LOADING REQUIREMENTS, SECTION 62-542 LOCATION OF PARKING SPACES (3); PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE CUMULATIVE; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.**

WHEREAS, the City of Angus has determined that the Code of Ordinances, Chapter 62, Article V, Division 4, Section 62-542 be amended as follows:

**BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:**

Section 1

That Chapter 62, Article V, Division 4, Section 62-542 (3) be amended to read as follows: No parking shall be allowed except on a paved concrete, asphalt, or gravel parking space.

Section 2

This ordinance shall be cumulative of all provisions of ordinances and the City of Angus, Code of Ordinances, as amended, except where provisions of this ordinance are in direct conflict with the provisions of such ordinances and Code, in which event such conflicting provisions of such ordinances and Code are hereby repealed.


Section 3

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the City Council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable, and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared void, ineffective or unconstitutional by the valid judgment or final decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such ineffectiveness or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the City Council without the incorporation herein of any such void, ineffective or unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section 4

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, and it is ordained.
