ordinance no. 23

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS, APPROVING AND ADOPTING A BUDGET FOR THE TOWN FOR THE FISCAL YEAR APRIL 1, 1982, THROUGH MARCH 31, 1983, AND PROVIDING THAT EXPENDITURES FOR SAID FISCAL YEAR SHALL BE MADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH SAID BUDGET.

WHEREAS, the budget officer of the Town of Angus, Texas, has heretofore filed with the town secretary, a proposed budget for the city covering the fiscal year April 1, 1982, through March 31, 1983, and

WHEREAS, the governing body of the city has this date concluded its public hearing on said budget,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

SECTION 1: That a copy of said budget as approved by the town council be attached to this ordinance as Exhibit A and made a part hereof for all purposes.

SECTION 2: That said budget attached hereto as Exhibit A, be, and the same is hereby approved and adopted by the town council as the official budget for the city for the fiscal year aforesaid.

SECTION 3: That expenditures during the fiscal year shall be made in accordance with the budget approved by this ordinance unless otherwise authorized by a duly enacted ordinance of the city.

SECTION 4: That no expenditures under said budget shall be made without approval of the town council.

SECTION 5: That the necessity for making and approving a budget for the fiscal year as required by the laws of the State of Texas, creates an urgency and an emergency and requires that this ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage, as the law in such cases provides.

SECTION 6: That the town secretary shall file the approved budget as provided by state law.
