ORDINANCE NO. 25

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS TO ADD CHAPTER 11, SECTION 9.E. TO PROVIDE FOR A PERIOD OF SIX MONTHS BEFORE A SPECIAL USE ZONING PERMIT WHICH HAS BEEN DENIED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL SHALL AGAIN BE CONSIDERED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

SECTION I

THAT CHAPTER 11, SECTION 9 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO ADD SECTION 9.E. WHICH SHALL READ AS FOLLOWS:

- E. In the event an application for a special use permit is denied by the Town Council, a subsequent application for a special use permit on the same tract of land shall not be considered by the Town Council until a period of six months has elapsed from date of denial.

SECTION II

All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage, provided however, the restrictions on resubmission of applications for special use zoning permits provided for herein, shall not be applicable to an application submitted to the Town Council prior to adoption of this Ordinance.
