ORDINANCE NO. 29

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING FRANCHISE GRANTED TO ANGUS WATER SUPPLY CORPORATION.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

I

That Section 3 of the Franchise granted to Angus Water Supply Corporation on November 12, 1973, is hereby amended to read as follows:

SECTION 3.

The grantee shall, at its own cost and without expense to any of its customers or prospective consumers, wherever permanent improvements are located on the premises of such consumer or prospective consumer, construct and maintain service of proper size and capacity from its existing facilities to the property line of each consumer or prospective consumer, upon demand of such consumer or prospective consumer; but the grantee shall be entitled to charge and collect from such consumer or prospective consumer an installation fee for installing a service connection from such property line to its meter. Said installation or connection fee shall not exceed the sum of five hundred dollars (\$500.00). It is provided, however, that should grantee desire at any time thereafter to change the point of service to any consumer, such change in the service from the property line to the house necessitated by such change of service connection shall be borne by grantee.

II

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and publication as the law in such cases provides.
