ORDINANCE NO. 37

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS, TO ADD SUBSECTION 12.H TO SECTION 12, CHAPTER 1 ENTITLED TOWN COUNCIL RULES OF PROCEDURES TO PROVIDE FOR EXPENSES FOR MAYOR AND COUNCILMEMBERS; PROVIDING FOR REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS.

SECTION 1

THAT CHAPTER 1, SECTION 12 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS, IS HEREBY AMENDED TO ADD SUBSECTION H WHICH READS AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 12: TOWN COUNCIL RULES OF PROCEDURE

H. EXPENSES

The Mayor shall be reimbursed fifteen dollars (\$15.00) per meeting for expenses for each official city council meeting attended and each councilmember shall be reimbursed seven dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50) per meeting for expenses for each official city council meeting attended. Other expenses shall be reimbursed as approved by the city council.

SECTION II

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III

It is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall take effect June 1, 1985.



