ORDINANCE NO. 52

CITY OF ANGUS AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS AMENDING
SECTION 12.H, CHAPTER 1 OF THE CODE OF
ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGUS PERTAINING TO
COUNCIL THE PAYMENT OF MONTHLY COUNCIL EXPENSES;
ORDINANCES PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN
CONFLICT; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE;
AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

ARTICLE I

That Section 12.H of Chapter 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the
City of Angus, Texas be amended to read as follows:

SECTION 12: TOWN COUNCIL RULES OF PROCEDURE

H. SALARY AND EXPENSES

The mayor shall be reimbursed \$75 per month for expenses and
each councilmember shall be reimbursed \$25 per month.
Additional expenses may be reimbursed when receipts are pre-
sented for approval by the city council.

ARTICLE II

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith
are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

ARTICLE III

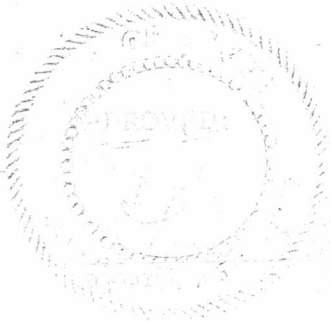
That it is hereby declared to be the intention of the city coun-
cil that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases
of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sen-
tence, paragraph, or section shall be declared unconstitutional
by the valid judgment or decree of any court of competent juris-
diction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the

remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation of any unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

ARTICLE IV

That this ordinance shall take effect upon January 16, 1988/May 21, 1988.
