OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS THE ADDING SECTION 7.H, CHAPTER 11 OF THE CODE OF ANGUS PERTAINING TO ANGUS PROVIDED THE MINIMUM LOT SIZE WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDED THE MINIMUM LOT SIZE WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDED THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; ANGUS PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BERIT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

SECTION I

That Section 7 of Chapter 11 of the Code of Ordinances of the code City of Angus, Texas is hereby amended to add subsection H which shall read as follows:

SECTION 11: RESIDENCE DEFINED

H. A minimum lot size of one-half $(\frac{1}{2})$ acre is hereby established with if the lot is served by a public water supply. In the event the lot is not served by a public water supply, the minimum lot size shall be one (1) acre.

SECTION II

That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

SECTION III

That it is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses, and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgment or decree of any

den, succourt of icompetent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall sining photosaffect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, this additional phrase, and sections of this ordinance, since the same would by conscil have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation and unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section.

SECTION IV

That whenever in this ordinance an act is prohibited or is made of an offendeclared to be unlawful or an offense or a misdemeanor, or the daily wherever in such ordinance, the doing of an act is required or declared the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, the violation tion of dany such provision shall be punished by a fine of not exceeding two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00); provided, however, that no penalty shall be greater or less than the penalty protate of the same or similar offense under the laws of the law of the state. The Each day lany violation of this ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense.

SECTION V

That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after the caption, as the law in such cases provides.




