ORDINANCE NO. 57

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS TO AMEND SECTION 14.A; CHAPTER 1 PROVIDING FOR REVISED ELECTION DATE; PROVIDING FOR THE REPEAL OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

SECTION I

That Chapter 1 of the Code of Ordinances of the City of Angus, Texas is hereby amended to amend section 14.A which shall read as follows:

SECTION 14: ELECTIONS

A. GOVERNED BY STATE AND FEDERAL LAW

All elections pertaining to municipal affairs shall be governed by the election laws of the state. Annual elections for city officials shall be held on the first Saturday in May of each year. Runoff elections required as a result of the election held on the first Saturday in May shall be held on the last Saturday in May. The election shall be held in accordance with the Texas Election Laws. The Federal Voting Rights Act is also applicable to any change affecting voting including change of polling place, annexation, and method of electing city councilmembers. Proposed changes affected by the Federal Voting Rights Act must be submitted to the U.S. Attorney General for approval.

SECTION II

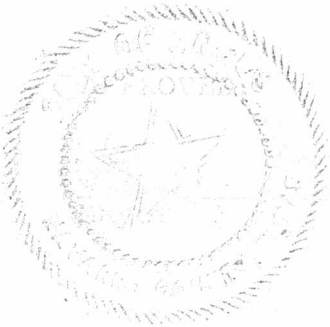
That all ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

That this ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage.

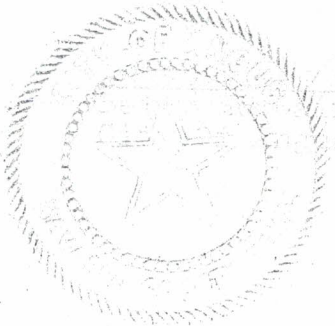
