# City of Angus, Texas Ordinance No. 60

TO AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TO FOR TEXAS CALLING FOR A SPECIAL ELECTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF AN ADDITIONAL ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT (1/2%) LOCAL SALES AND USE TAX WITHIN THE CITY.

#### BEIT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS TEXAS:

#### Section 1: Election to be Called

The City Council, by a majority vote, does hereby call a special election for the adoption of an additional one-half of one percent (1/2%) local sales and use tax within the City of Angus. This sales tax shall be imposed upon all taxable items sold within the city which are subject to taxation by the State of Texas under the provisions of the Limited Sales, Excise, and Use Tax Act. Such election shall not be less than thirty (30) days following adoption of the ordinance calling for such election and will be held on the next uniform election date being August 13, 1988.

#### Section 2: Notice of Election to be Published

That the City Secretary is hereby authorized to publish notice of said election in the official space newspaper of the City on the same day for two successive weeks. The date of the first publication shall be at least twenty-one (21) days prior to the date set for such election.

#### Section 3: City Secretary to Notify State Comptroller if Tax Approved

Should a majority of voters voting at such election approve the adoption of the additional sales tax, the City Secretary shall immediately notify the State Comptroller of such adoption. Such tax will then become effective on the first day of the first calendar year next succeeding a whole calendar quarter following the notice to the Comptroller of the adopted of such tax, January 1, 1989.
