

CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS ADOPTING SUPPLEMENT NO. 8 TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS; WHICH SPECIFICALLY INCLUDES CORRECTIONS TO CITY ORDINANCES TO COMPLY WITH STATE LAW; THE ELIMINATION OF CONFLICTS WITH THE NEW ZONING ORDINANCE; AND DELETING PENALTY PROVISIONS THAT ARE IN CONFLICT WITH CHAPTER 1, SECTION 5; CHANGING THE NAME OF TOWN TO CITY ON THOSE PAGES REPLACED BY THE SUPPLEMENT; PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500.00 EXCEPT FOR VIOLATIONS THAT GOVERN FIRE SAFETY, ZONING AND PUBLIC HEALTH AND SANITATION, INCLUDING THE DUMPING OF REFUSE, IN WHICH CASE THE FINE SHALL BE \$2,000.00; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS ADOPTING SUPPLEMENT NO. 8 TO THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS; WHICH SPECIFICALLY INCLUDES CORRECTIONS TO CITY ORDINANCES TO COMPLY WITH STATE LAW; THE ELIMINATION OF CONFLICTS WITH THE NEW ZONING ORDINANCE; AND DELETING PENALTY PROVISIONS THAT ARE IN CONFLICT WITH CHAPTER 1, SECTION 5; CHANGING THE NAME OF TOWN TO CITY ON THOSE PAGES REPLACED BY THE SUPPLEMENT; PROVIDING FOR A GENERAL PENALTY FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE CODE IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500.00 EXCEPT FOR VIOLATIONS THAT GOVERN FIRE SAFETY, ZONING AND PUBLIC HEALTH AND SANITATION, INCLUDING THE DUMPING OF REFUSE, IN WHICH CASE THE FINE SHALL BE \$2,000.00; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; REPEALING CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

Section 1

That Supplement No. 8 to the "Code of Ordinances of the City of Angus, Texas" is hereby adopted and as hereinafter inserted. Such supplement which more specifically removes conflicts with state law; deletes penalty provisions with are in conflict with Chapter 1, Section 5 of the Code of Ordinances, eliminates conflicts with the city's new zoning ordinance; and amends the word "town" to "city" on those pages replaced by the supplement. Such supplement is hereby made a part of this ordinance as if the same as if fully incorporated and copied herein.

That Supplement No. 8 to the "Code of Ordinances of the City of Angus, Texas" is hereby adopted and as hereinafter inserted. Such supplement which more specifically removes conflicts with state law; deletes penalty provisions with are in conflict with Chapter 1, Section 5 of the Code of Ordinances, eliminates conflicts with the city's new zoning ordinance; and amends the word "town" to "city" on those pages replaced by the supplement. Section 2

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 except for violations of that govern fire safety, zoning and public health and sanitation, including the dumping of refuse, in which case the fine shall be \$2,000.00. Furthermore, each and every day any such violation of this ordinance shall continue it shall constitute a separate offense.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction, shall be subject to a fine of not more than \$500.00 except for violations of that govern fire safety, zoning and public health and sanitation, including the dumping of refuse, in which case the fine shall be \$2,000.00. Furthermore, each and every day any such violation of this ordinance shall continue it shall constitute a separate offense.

Section 3

That is is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

That is is hereby declared to be the intention of the city council that the sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this ordinance are severable and, if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional by the valid judgement or decree of any court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs and sections of this ordinance, since the same would have been enacted by the city council without the incorporation in this ordinance of any such unconstitutional phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section.

Section 4

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are, to the extent of such conflict, hereby repealed.

Section 5

This ordinance shall take effect immediately from and after its passage and the publication of its caption, as the law in such cases provides.

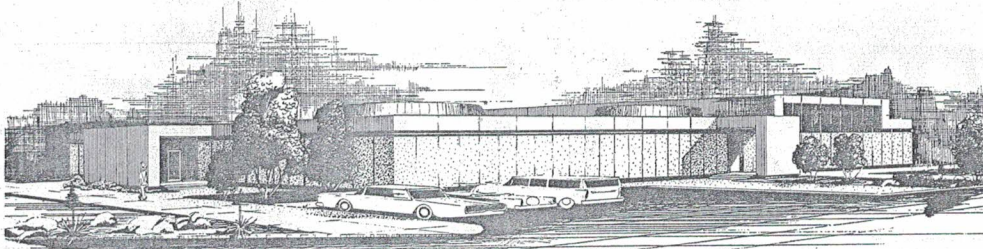

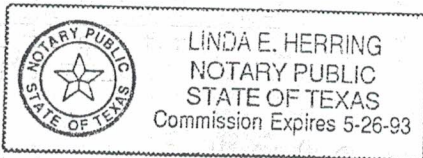

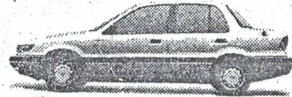
