ORDINANCE NO. 84

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS, DEFINING FIREWORKS AND PROHIBITING THEIR SALE; PROVIDING FOR EXCEPTIONS; ESTABLISHING AUTHORITY TO SEIZE FIREWORKS FOUND IN VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY OF THIS ORDINANCE; PROVIDING FOR ANY CONFLICTING PROVISIONS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE FOR THIS ORDINANCE.

NOW BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ANGUS, TEXAS:

Section I. Fireworks Regulations Adopted

That Chapter 5 of the City of Angus Code of Ordinances be revised by the addition of Section 3, said Section 3 to read as follows:

"SECTION 3: FIREWORKS

A. FIREWORKS DEFINED

Fireworks means and includes any combustible or explosive composition, or any substance or combination of substances, or device prepared for the purpose of producing a visible or an audible effect by combustion, explosion, deflagration, or detonation, and shall include blank cartridges, toy pistols, toy cannons, toy canes, or toy guns in which explosives are used, firecrackers, torpedoes, skyrockets, Roman candles, Daygo bombs, sparklers, or other devices of like construction and any devices containing any explosive or flammable compound or any tablet or other device containing an explosive substance, except that the term "fireworks" shall not include any auto flares, paper caps containing not in excess of an average of twenty-five hundredths (0.25) of a grain of explosive content per cap, and toy pistols, toy canes, toy guns or other devices for use of such caps, the sale and use of which shall be permitted at all times.

B. SALE OF FIREWORKS PROHIBITED

No person shall manufacture, assemble, store, exhibit, or have in his possession, with intent to give away or sell or offer for sale or sell within the city limits of the City of Angus, any fireworks of any kind in the city.

C. EXCEPTIONS; DISPLAYS

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit the sale or use of fireworks by railroads or other transportation agencies for signal purposes of illumination; or the sale or use of blank cartridges for a show or theater; or for signal or ceremonial purposes in athletics or sports; or for use by military organizations or to the sale, storage, or use of flashlight composition by photographers or dealers in photographic supplies; or to prevent any public or private demonstration or display of fireworks of any kind if conducted under the supervision of the fire marshal after application is

made and written permit is issued by the fire marshal for such demonstration or display. Such permit shall not be granted until written application therefore has been filed with the fire marshal, nor unless such demonstration or display shall be of such character, and so located, discharged or fired as in the opinion of the fire marshal, shall not be hazardous to property or endanger the public safety.

D. SEIZURE OF FIREWORKS

The fire marshal, or his designate, of the City of Angus shall have the authority to seize, take, remove, or cause to be removed at the expense of the owner or person in charge of fireworks offered or exposed for sale, stored, or held in violation hereof. The fire marshal shall dispose of in any safe way any such fireworks confiscated."

Section II. Penalty for Violations

Any person, firm, or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction shall be fined in an amount not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00), and each and every day's violation shall constitute a separate offense.

Section III. Severability of Ordinance

If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, phrase, or word in this ordinance, and the competent jurisdiction, such holding shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of the ordinance, and the City Council of the City of Angus hereby declares that it would have passed such remaining portions of the ordinance despite such invalidity.

Section IV. Conflicting Provisions

Any and all ordinances of the City of Angus heretofore adopted which are in conflict with this ordinance are hereby expressly repealed insofar as the same are in conflict therewith.

Section V. Effective Date

This ordinance shall take effect immediately, from and after its passage and publication of the caption, as the law in such cases provides.


